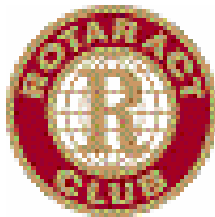

Directions from downtown B'ham to cleanup site, Buddy Vines Camp

Take I 59/20 West to Tuscaloosa. Take exit #120 "Ensley Avenue 20th Street". Bear right at the bottom of the ramp. You are now on highway 269 and the mile markers start from "0". Follow this road straight for 15 miles to the 15 mile marker. Just past the marker is an intersection with BP station. Turn left onto Short Creek Rd. Follow to dead end. Turn left onto Alliance Rd. Go 1.2 miles to top of third hill and take a hard right onto "Buddy Vines Camp Rd". Follow main road 2.7 miles to camp.
